1. Judging will be held on Friday July 22 at 4 pm going in the order of the classes **unless otherwise noted.**
2. Exhibitors in the 4-H Poultry Department are not eligible to exhibit in the FFA Poultry Department or vice-versa.
3. Poultry will follow American Poultry Association American Standard of Perfection. Book available at the Extension office.
4. Any questions and/or problems in an animal barn are to be addressed to the superintendent of the barn.
5. Morning chores are to be done by 8:00 a.m. and evening chores are to be done by 7:00 p.m.
6. An exhibitor may sell 5 poultry total through the livestock sale
7. Exhibitors **MUST collect and remove eggs from the barn daily. This helps with keeping predators out.**
8. Eggs are **NOT** to be thrown in the barn.
9. Shoes are to be worn at all times while in the barn.
10. No small appliances are allowed such as microwaves, crockpots, coffee pots, refrigerators, freezers, skillets, toasters, etc. The only appliance allowed is the fair board owned freezer.
11. Proper poultry food and water dishes are to be used to prevent spillage. **No egg cartons, butter dishes, cool whip containers, or tin cans are allowed.**

EGG SHOW

1. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries in each lot.
2. Eggs entered must be produced by his or her own flock.
3. All eggs shall be properly cleaned, dried and in a carton (dozen). Any entry that is dirty or has an odor shall be disqualified.
4. Judges reserve the right to move eggs from one classification to another when they have been entered in the wrong class according to class definitions.
5. The eggs are usually judged by weight, uniformity of color, uniformity of shape and shell texture.
6. Judges criteria based on his or her own point system.

Lot 1- White- The color as close as reasonably possible to white.

Lot 2- Brown – The color as close as reasonably possible, including dark and light brown. Creams and Beiges are classified as pastel.

Lot 3 – Pastels – Includes Blue, Greens, Pink, Beige, and Creams

Lot 4 – Bantams – Weight criteria does not apply
