1. Judging will be held on Thursday July 22nd at 6:00 pm
2. Exhibitors in the 4-H Rabbit Department are not eligible to exhibit in the FFA Rabbit Department or vice-versa.
3. Rabbits will follow the American Rabbit breeders Association Standard of Perfection (SOP). The SOP book is available at the Extension office.
4. Any questions and/or problems in an animal barn are to be addressed to the superintendent of the barn.
5. Morning chores are to be done by 8:00 a.m. and evening chores are to be done by 6:00 p.m.
6. An exhibitor may sell 5 head of rabbits total through the livestock sale

CLASS B – RABBIT (MEAT TYPE)

Meat rabbits will be judged according to criteria set in the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of perfection official guidebook.

Lot 1 – Single fryer (Between 3.5 & 5.5 lbs. & not over 70 days old)

Lot 2 – Meat pen – 3 rabbits of the same breed and variety. Each rabbit must weigh 3.5-5.5 lbs.

Lot 3– Roaster not over 6 months (Between 5.5-9 lbs.)

CLASS C – COMMERCIAL BREED

Breeds considered in this class are: American, American Chinchilla, Argent Brun, Beveren, Blanc de Hotot, Californian, Champagne D'argent, Checkered Giant, Cinnamon, Crème D'argent, English Lop, Flemish Giant, French Lop, Giant Angora, Giant Chinchilla, New Zealand, Palomino, Satin, Silver Fox.

Commercial Breed rabbits will be judged according to criteria set in the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of perfection official guidebook. No Crossbred rabbits will be allowed in the commercial breed class.

CLASS D - FANCY BREED

Breeds considered in this class are: American Fuzzy Lop, American Sable, Belgian Hare, Britannia Petite, Dutch, Dwarf Hotot, English Angora, English Spot, Florida White, French Angora, Harlequin, Havana, Himalayan, Holland Lop, Jersey Woolly, Lilac, Lion Head, Mini Lop, Mini Rex, Mini Satin, Netherland Dwarf, Polish, Rex, Rhinelander, Satin Angora, Silver, Silver Marten, Standard Chinchilla, Tan, Thrianta.

Fancy Breed rabbits will be judged according to criteria set in the American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of perfection official guidebook. No Crossbred rabbits will be allowed in the Fancy breed class.
